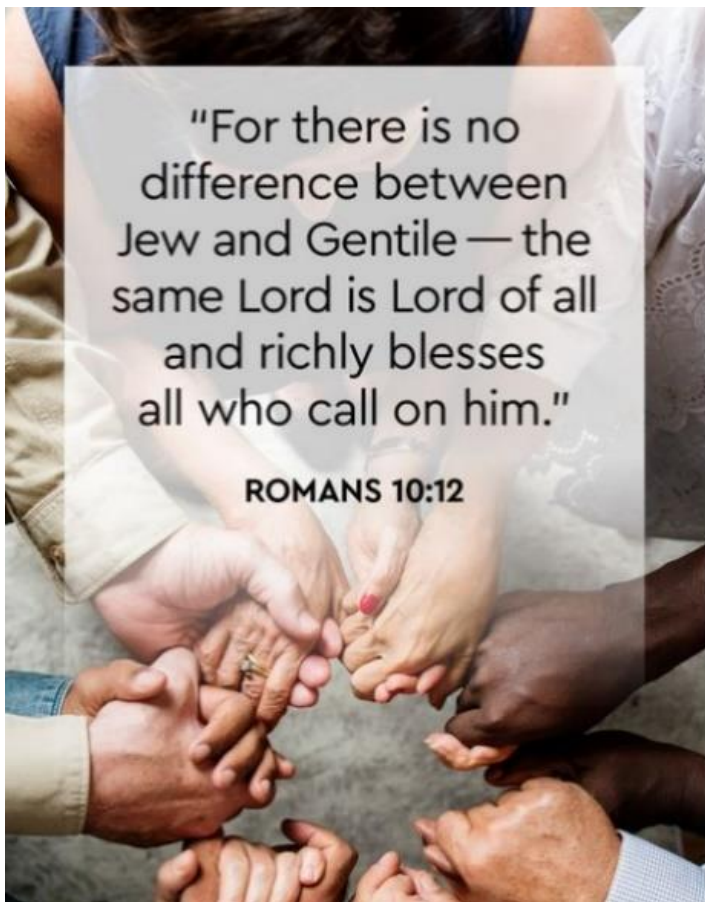


Theme of the Week: Our Amazing City – A Diverse People

On Wednesday 14th June the Junior Town Sports competition held at Withdean Stadium. This involved a Year 7 and 8 team competing a variety of track field events. It was a particularly hot afternoon, so all the athletes did amazingly well to compete in those temperatures. We took around 40 students to this athletic competition which was fantastic to see so many students in Years 7 and 8 competing and representing their school so well. Team and individual results are

below, but I wanted to highlight two particular students:

- Arthur R won both his events and was only 30 cm off the Year 7 Javelin record (a throw of 37.36m)– currently held by our Year 11 student Louis O!
- The second student is Keren N – she won both her 100m events on Monday and Wednesday and was presented with a trophy for being the fastest U14 girl across Brighton and Hove!
